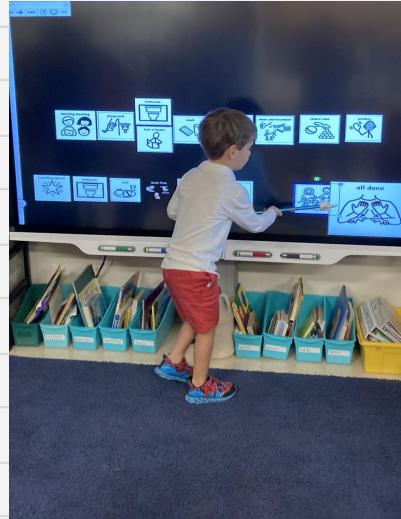


MORNING MEETING

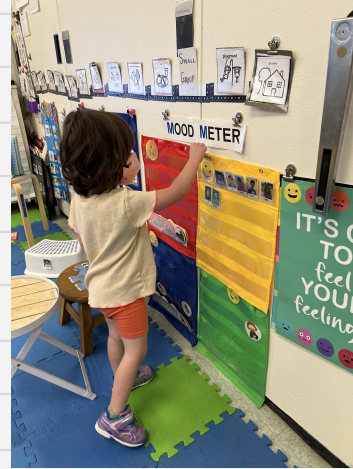


A typical Morning Meeting includes:

CHOICE TIME

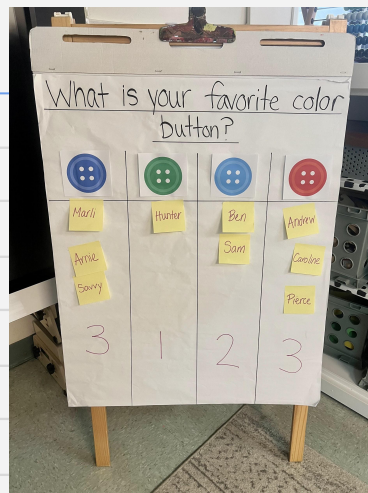


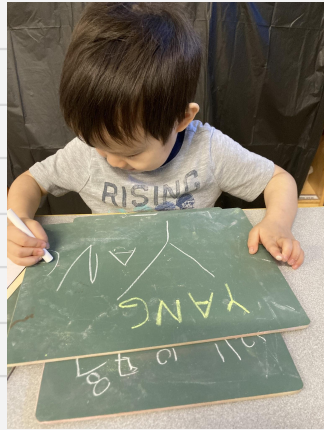
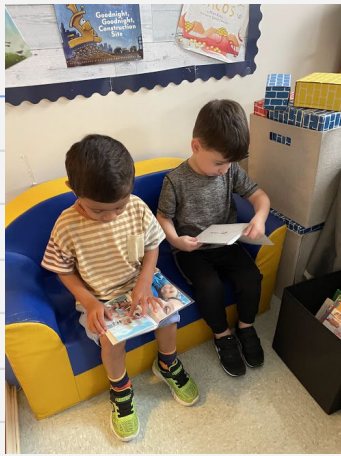
Choice time offers opportunities to address many areas of development including social skills like turn taking, sharing, play skills and emotional regulation. It is a fun and exciting time in the classroom.

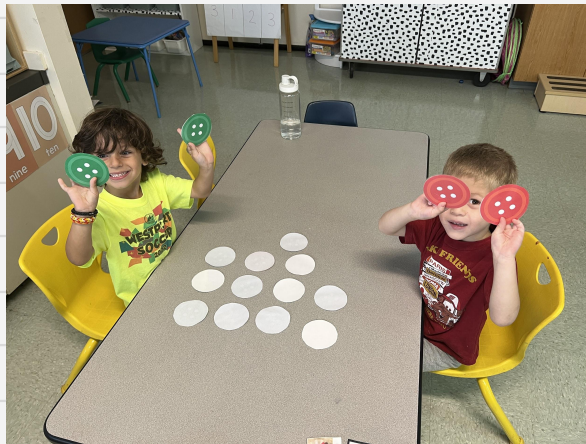

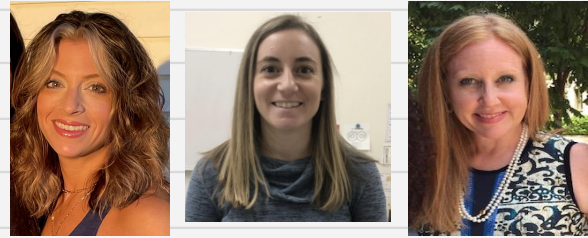
